Volunteered an approximate total of 399 volunteer hours



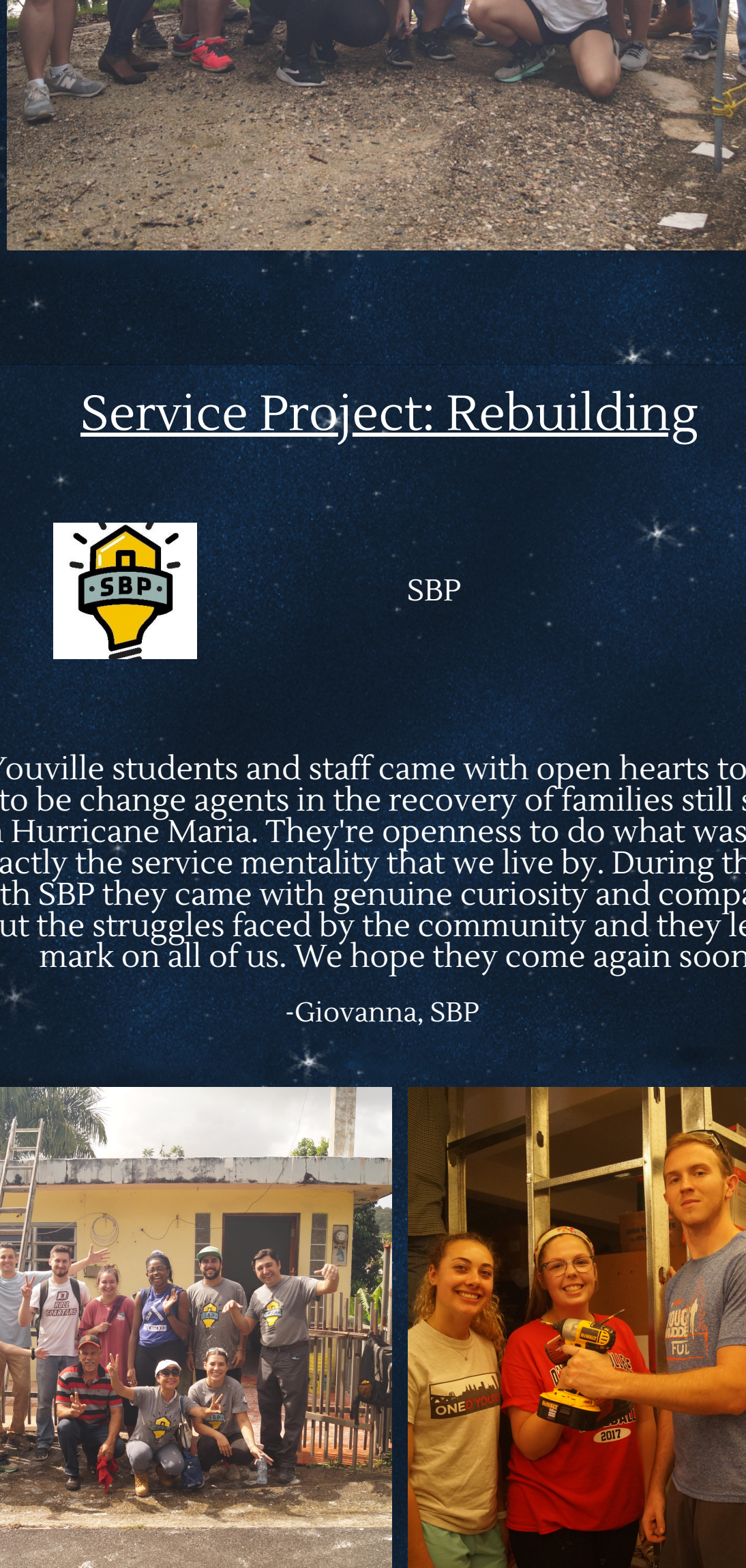
An estimated \$10,146.57 philanthropic impact
